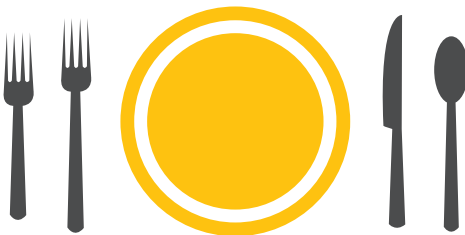
Access to Care

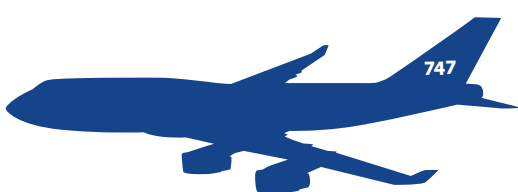
